Section 551.071 For the purpose of private consultation between the District and its attorney when the attorney's advice with respect to pending or contemplated litigation settlement offers, and matters where the duty of the District's counsel to his client pursuant to the Code of Professional Responsibility of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with the Open Meetings Act.

A: Section 551.072 For the purpose of discussion with respect to the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property, if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the District in negotiations with a third person.


